

## 6<sup>th</sup> AUTONOMOUS ENGINEERING COLLEGES INTER COLLEGIATE GAMES MEET

(AECICGM) 2019-2020

### Rules and Regulation for the participating colleges in the AECICGM 2019-2020

- 6<sup>th</sup> Autonomous Engineering Colleges Inter Collegiate Games Meet-2019-20 (Men & Women) is scheduled from 09<sup>th</sup> to 11<sup>th</sup> January, 2020, at SVCET, Chittoor.
- All the participants are required to attend the event with their College ID card/Bonafide certificate issued by the respective head of the institution.
- Registration form and Eligibility form can be downloaded from our college website [www.svcetedu.org](http://www.svcetedu.org)
- Registration form and Eligibility form should be sent to the Organizing Secretary, on or before 09.12.2019.
- Maximum registration fee is Rs.7000/- for each institution (Rs.500 per each game). However, for Cricket it is Rs.2000/- per team, and for Chess it is Rs.200/- per participant. The registration form along with the prescribed fee, in the form of D.D. in favor of **Principal, Sri Venkateswara College of Engineering and Technology, Chittoor, payable at Chittoor**, should be submitted for confirmation of participation.
- There should be minimum participation of six teams to organize the matches, failing which that particular event will be cancelled.
- Unfurnished accommodation will be provided to the Teams.
- A caution deposit of Rs.1000/- has to be paid by the Physical Director/Team Manager to the Accommodation Incharge, and the same will be refunded after adjustment of the cost of damage, if any.
- Physical Directors/Team Managers Meeting will be held at tournament venue i.e.SVCET, Chittoor, on 08.01.2020 at 4.00P.M. Physical Directors/Team Managers are requested to attend this meeting.
- Managers and participants should bring their own lock & key to protect their equipment/belongings. Organizers are not responsible for the loss of your belongings/equipments.
- All the Physical Directors of the participating colleges are requested to bring their concerned college flag. Flags are essential and compulsory for the parade to be held on 09<sup>th</sup> January, 2020. Attending the Inaugural Ceremony is mandatory.

- All the team players should stick to their individual college sports dress code during the inaugural ceremony and also during their participation in various events.
- All the participating college Physical Directors/Team Managers and players are requested to report to the Organizing Secretary by 8:00A.M on 09-01-2020 at Sri Venkateswara College of Engineering and Technology, Chittoor.
- No protests will be entertained and the **Decision of the Umpire is final**. Further, the decision of the tournament committee on all matters relating to the tournament shall be final and binding.
- The organizing secretary reserves the right to make any changes in the programme without any prior intimation. The morning session starts at 8.00A.M., and the afternoon session starts at 2.00P.M.
- All the Physical Directors of the participating colleges are requested to strictly follow the match schedule and should report with their teams at least half-an-hour before the commencement of the matches at their respective venues.
- Kindly confirm your college team's participation/withdrawal, if any, on or before 09.12.2019.
- Each college should appoint a Physical Director / Manager to represent their respective college.
- Physical Directors/Team Managers are totally responsible for ensuring that their players are disciplined throughout the three-day event.
- In case of participants engaging in in-disciplinary activities during the course of the three day event , action will be initiated against the participants, leading to disqualification of the teams from the tournament.
- In-disciplinary activity of participants during the events/tournament shall attract serious action against the team, including disqualification from the tournament.
- All the Physical Directors/ Team Managers are requested to get their own rackets and kits for Table Tennis, Badminton and Ball Badminton events. Further, you are required to bring your own kit for cricket.
- TA/DA will be borne by the respective colleges for the participants & Physical Directors.
- In case of teams having common players and any player of a particular team not reporting on scheduled time, walkover will be given to opponent team.
- Colleges having multiple campuses should not bring other college players for the event. If other college players are included in the team then the team is subject to disqualification.

- In case of complaints pertaining to the identity of the students, it is the responsibility of the institution to prove the identity of the players by producing sufficient evidence.
- On arrival at Chittoor please contact the concerned committee members if you face any difficulty to reach the Tournament venue/Accommodation Venue.
